## Breaking News: A "Game-Changer" for Cat Guardians!

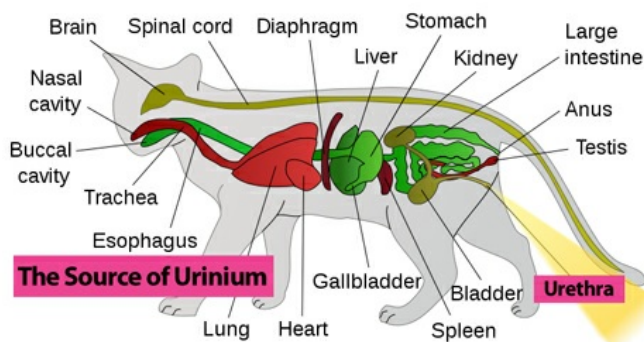

After decades of much heated debate, the [International Union of Pure & Applied Chemistry](#) <sup>[2]</sup> assigned a new Element. Like it's 118 predecessors, number 119 is a pure chemical substance consisting of one type of atom distinguished by its atomic number, which is the number of protons in its nucleus. **Element 119 bears the name, Urinium.**

**It's believed that Urinium was first discovered in 1855 by Dr. Joseph King after his tabby cat, [Mossander](#) <sup>[3]</sup> soaked samples he was using in his research to find a new element.** What he was close to discovering was [Cesium](#) <sup>[4]</sup>, which eventually documented by noted scientists, Robert Wilhelm Bunsen (*later of Bunsen Burner fame*) and Gustav Robert Kirchoff.
